



**Balance Inc.** is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, established in 1991, that supports individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) in Ozaukee County.

Balance's primary objectives are to:

- Improve the quality of life of individuals with IDD by balancing support and independence.
- Enhance the communities' capacity to understand and embrace people with IDD.



## PROGRAMS

### ADULT FAMILY HOMES

Balance owns/operates eight Adult Family Homes (AFH) in Ozaukee County. These homes provide:

- An affordable and supportive living environment
- Group living that helps combat social isolation
- 24/7 staff support

### ADULT DAY PROGRAM

An active community-based program for adults with IDD which provides:

- Stability and routine for participants
- Multiple daily community outings and volunteer opportunities that keep participants engaged

### SUPPORTED LIVING

Balance supports adults with IDD who currently live on their own. This program assists with:

- Household and money management
- Community outings and social connectedness

### CHILDREN'S SOCIAL SKILLS

An after-school program for children ages 5 to 17 with IDD. This program provides:

- Relationship building
- Community outings and in-house activities

### CHILDREN'S SUMMER RECREATION

A summer day camp offered to children ages 5 to 15 with IDD. This program includes:

- Swimming, boating, fishing, parks and more
- Confidence and relationship-building

## FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

### Adult Family Homes

- \$5,000 – New flooring installed in one house
- \$7,000 – Weekend activities for 25 residents for one year
- \$10,000 – Landscaping upgrades to reduce yearly maintenance

### Adult Day Program

- \$1,000 – Dance classes for one year
- \$5,000 – Music classes for one year
- \$7,500 – Gas to transport participants to 2000+ community outings each year
- \$10,000 – Art classes for one year

### Children's Summer Recreation

- \$4,500 – Camp activities for one summer
- \$7,000 – Bus transportation to/from daily camp activities for one summer
